Phrasal Verbs

verb + adverb particle

Some take an object and some do not

- When taking an object:
 - noun objects can come before or after the adverb (separable)
 - pronoun objects come only before the adverb



Prepositional Verbs

verb + preposition

They always take an object

 Objects (either nouns or pronouns) always come after the preposition (non-separable)



Phrasal-Prepositional Verbs

verb + adverb particle + preposition

They always take an object

 Objects (either nouns or pronouns) always come after the preposition (non-separable)



Comparison Table

Multi-Word Verbs	Adverb/Preposition	Transitive/Intransitive	Separable
phrasal	adverb	both	yes
prepositional	preposition	transitive	no
Phrasal-prepositional	both	transitive	no
